



Ridge Transportation

Our agency's fleet of handicapped-accessible buses and vehicles provide transportation to hundreds of individuals who attend our programs.

The Ridge Transportation full-service repair facility ensures the safety and efficiency of all Schenectady ARC vehicles, as well as many vehicles for other non-profit agencies throughout the Capital District.

Certifications in Defensive Driving and 19A are also provided through Ridge Service to Schenectady ARC staff as well as individuals from other agencies.

In addition, Ridge Service provides transportation for Medicaid medical transports and volunteers for various activities for the City of Schenectady, the Chamber of Schenectady County and the Albany-Colonie Regional Chamber of Commerce.

BUSING SOLUTIONS

Schenectady ARC has 22 handicapped-accessible buses and over 120 vehicles that have provided safe and comfortable transportation to over 500 individuals who attend our programs. The Ridge Service Fleet of busses traveled almost 400,000 miles in 2012.

SAFETY RECORD

The Department of Transportation (DOT) inspection pass rate of our vehicles was 96% in 2012, well above the national average of 79%.

ANCILLARY SERVICES

Ridge Service provides transportation for Medicaid medical transports, the Seniors for Rotterdam group, and has volunteered for the Schenectady City Lights Tour and the Chamber of Schenectady County.

Certifications in Defensive Driving and 19A are also provided through Ridge Service to Schenectady ARC staff, as well as individuals from other agencies.

FLEET MAINTENANCE

The agency's full-service repair facility services approximately 200 vehicles per year, including vehicles belonging to seven other non-profit agencies. Vehicles undergo rigorous inspections to ensure the safety of all occupants that are being transported.
